1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 11:30 A.M.

2. Attendance

3. Public Comment

Mr. Teichman advised that no request for public comment was received and that no one is present to offer comment.

4. Approval of Minutes – Friday, February 28th, 2025, Meeting

Mr. Allen offered a motion to approve the minutes of the Friday, February 28th, 2025, meeting and was seconded by Mr. Stokes. The motion was approved unanimously.

Items for Action and/or referral to the Policy Committee

5. Approval of Amendment No. 37 to the FY 2025-2029 TIP in FY 2025, consisting a state-only funding increase for District 5 project C085, for smart overlays on I-55 at the northbound and southbound ramps at the Towanda interchange, at a total cost of \$750,000, for Designed Overlay/Resurfacing.

Mr. Stokes offered a motion to approve Item 5 (Amendment No. 37) and was seconded by Mr. Otto. The motion was approved unanimously.

6. Approval of a resolution of adoption of IDOT performance targets for Pavement and Bridges (PM2) and System Performance (PM3), as promulgated by the Illinois Secretary of Transportation on September 30, 2024.

Mr. Allen offered a motion to approve Item 6 and was seconded by Mr. Stokes. The motion was approved unanimously.

Items of Information or Discussion

11. Project Updates

- a) Mr. Lai informed the committee regarding the Go:Safe McLean County Action Plan update, which is funded by a Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) grant from the FHWA. The Commission approved a contract with the consultant, Lochmueller Group, at their March 2025 meeting. A project steering committee (PSC) will be established.
- b) Mr. Lai provided an update on the Veterans Parkway Corridor Plan, which is funded by a Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability & Equity (RAISE) grant from the FHWA. The next Project Steering Committee (PSC) will meet next in May 2025. The consultant, TY Lin, continues to make progress with project tasks and analysis.
- c) Mr. Allen informed the committee that the project on Business U.S 51 will be pushed to a November letting from a June letting.
